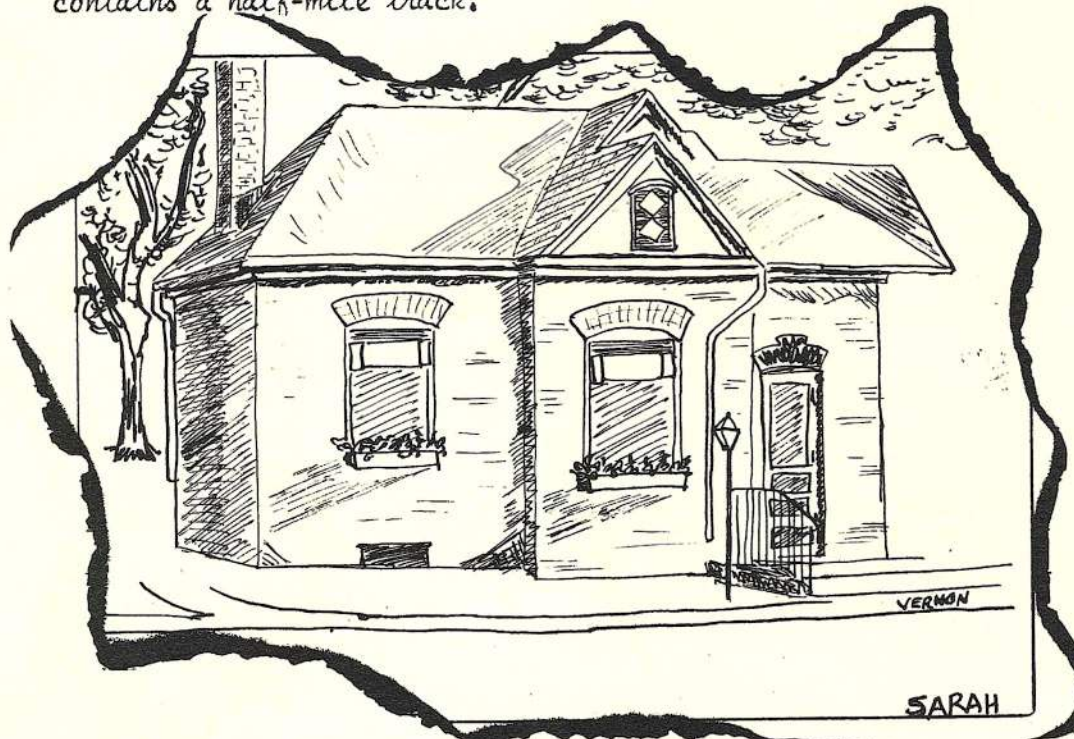


FALL - 1848
